Guidelines for Submission

- Full papers must be submitted directly to the selected track via the Easychair link https://easychair.org/account/signin. cgi?key=53385880.boeQ0SNiF0IpNXrQ) online submission system, latest by 21st July, 2017.
- · Each paper can be submitted to only one track.
- At the time of submission, submitted papers must not have been published or accepted for publication anywhere else.
- We will not accept any changes in the paper title, abstract, authorship, and actual paper after the submission deadline.
- · Formatting guidelines:
- 1) Full papers (Presentation Papers) must be fewer than 10,000 words inclusive of all materials, including appendices and references.
- 2) Figures, graphs, tables, appendices and references should follow the Academy of Management Journal's Style Guide.
- 3) Use Times New Roman 12-point font, double spaced, 1-inch (2.5 cm) margin all around, and 8.5"A-11" page setting. References can be single spaced.
- 4) Number all pages of the paper.
- 5) Each submission must state the submission track and session format (Presentation or Poster at the time of submission.
- 6) Each manuscript should also be accompanied by an abstract, not to exceed 150 words.
- 7) The document must not contain any identifying information to facilitate the blind review process. The acknowledgements and self-referencing, that gives away the authors' identity should be avoided. If self-referencing is essential, it should be in third person.

Note: Submitted paper that do not adhere to the above instructions, will NOT be reviewed.
